

Saronic Gulf and Southern Peloponnese 10 day Easy Cruise .

This itinerary is a much more laid back. You will be sailing in the Saronic Gulf and around the Southern Peloponnese Coast. The sailing is easy with distances between island small and weather much more predictable and calm.

Day 1

Athens to Epidavros village, stops along the way for swimming Epidavros is the site of one of the best Ancient Amphitheatres in Europe. It is still used today for plays and concerts. A great place to visit. Epidavros also has a scuba center that can organize dives to ancient wrecks and geological steps in the sea bed.. booking in advance required.

Sailing time 4 hrs.. (30 miles).

Day 2

Leaving around mid morning after you have had a chance to visit the theater, we will sail to the Island of Poros. Poros is a cosmopolitan island with great shopping and some wonderful beaches and bays to visit and hide in. Sailing time about 3 hrs with stop for swimming.. (20 miles).

Day 3

Leaving Poros around mid morning, a short sail to the secret cove of Teslavina for Lunch and swimming. Before sailing to on to the Little Greek fishing village of Erimioni . Here you will be lost in this quiet village that has been here for over 3000 years. Total sailing time 4 hrs for 25 miles.

Day 4

Leaving Erimioni a good sail to the town of Leonidion birthplace of King Leonidas of Sparta. The little port is nestled in under huge mountains that stand tall like Spartain soldiers. The sail will be across the Argolic Gulf and take about 3-4 hrs depending on wind. 30 miles

Day 5

Leaving Leondion a short lunch time stop by the town of Tolon before sailing on to Navplion. Navplion was the Ancient capital of Greece. It is over looked by a massive fort/Castle built by the ancient Phoenicians. (25 miles)

Day 6

Exploring Navplion town

Day 7

Leaving Navplion for the return trip to Athens. Sail to the town of Astros on the Southern Peloponnese coast. From here you can visit the ancient city of Mycenae . (15 miles)

Day 8.

We start our trip back to Athens sailing from Astros to the island of Sepstai and anchor in a secluded harbor for the night. Spetsai has been the center of wooden ship building here in the Saronic Gulf for many years. Take a moment and visit the old shipwrights in the old town. Sailing time from Astros 3 hrs (25 miles)

Day 9.

Sepstai to the island of Hydra for a lunch time stop and a chance to visit a unique island. Here there are no cars and only donkeys for transportation and some of the greatest rock beaches around. Around mid afternoon we will leave Hydra and sail back to Poros where we will anchor in a private cove for the night and enjoy an evening on the anchor and an on board cooked meal. 25 miles

Day 10.

Poros island back to Athens Marina about 4 hours sailing time.

(30 miles)
